

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (CASTLETHORPE ROAD, HANSLOPE) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes intends, in not less than seven days from the date of this Notice, to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering, waiting or proceeding along that part of Castlethorpe Road, Hanslope between 23 & 43 Castlethorpe Road to enable installation of a new sewer connection and installation of culverts to existing ditches, the temporary closure will be in effect on **12th April 2021 – 9th May 2021 (24Hours)**.

Whilst the above length of road is closed, the alternative route will be via Gold Street, Park Road, Wolverton Road, North Street, Hanslope Road and Castlethorpe Road (and Vice Versa).

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for emergency services vehicles and military vehicles being driven on operational duties and Residents.

The closure will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual.

The temporary closure will be in force on the date shown when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs displayed in the affected part of road.

All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closure at least one week prior to works taking place.

The proposed Order will come into operation on **12th April 2021** and will continue in force for a maximum period of 3 month or until the said works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. If the works are not completed within the maximum period stated, a further order may be made.

Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as is prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
